Saturday 09/26/2026 2:00pm Fall Monarch Butterfly Program

Terry Willis will present his popular Monarch Butterfly program, reviewing the life cycle and amazing migration of this annual visitor to the refuge. If possible, the program will include butterfly tagging (weather backup program date October 3rd, 2:00pm)

Saturday 10/16/2026 1:00pm Bombay Hook Waterfowl Program

Delaware F&W biologist Cole Tiemann will review the waterfowl that breed and migrate through Bombay Hook NWR. He will give us an update on the fall migration along the Atlantic flyway.

Saturday 10/31/2026 1pm Secrets of the Bombay Hook Forests

Kesha Brauskill and Bruce Lantz will share some of the natural secrets of the forests of Bombay Hook NWR. Come learn what surprising secrets the forest has to offer. (Costumes are optional)

Saturday 11/14/2026 1:00pm Tri State Bird Rescue, Program Research Presentation
